EXHIBITION CHRONOLOGIES:

Pat Hearn Gallery and American Fine Arts, Co.

The Pat Hearn Gallery and American Fine Arts, Co., chronologies were assembled in February 2016 by the CCS Bard Archives in an attempt to bring together an account of each gallery's exhibitions, performances, and other programming events. This document compiles published chronologies issued by those responsible for the two galleries' programming, enriched and verified with the contents of the archival collection held at CCS Bard Archives, the Colin de Land, American Fine Arts, Co., and Pat Hearn Gallery Archives (MSS.008). The Pat Hearn Gallery chronology was compiled using the finding aid The Guide to the Colin de Land, American Fine Arts, Co., and Pat Hearn Gallery Archives (MSS.008), in addition to the chronology included in the Pat Hearn memorial service program, 2000. The American Fine Arts, Co., exhibition chronology was also compiled using the finding aid, as well as the AFA exhibition chronology published in Dennis Balk's Colin de Land: American Fine Arts (New York: Powerhouse Books, 2008), which was originally prepared from a chronology produced by Jackie McAllister for Artforum's February 2005 issue. These chronologies were prepared by Ryan Evans (former CCS) Bard archivist) and supplemented by research conducted for the exhibition publication The Conditions of Being Art, Pat Hearn Gallery and American Fine Arts, Co. (New York: CCS Bard and Dancing Foxes Press, 2018). The chronologies are published with the hope that they will be augmented through future research by a diverse community of scholars, curators, artists, and other community members.
